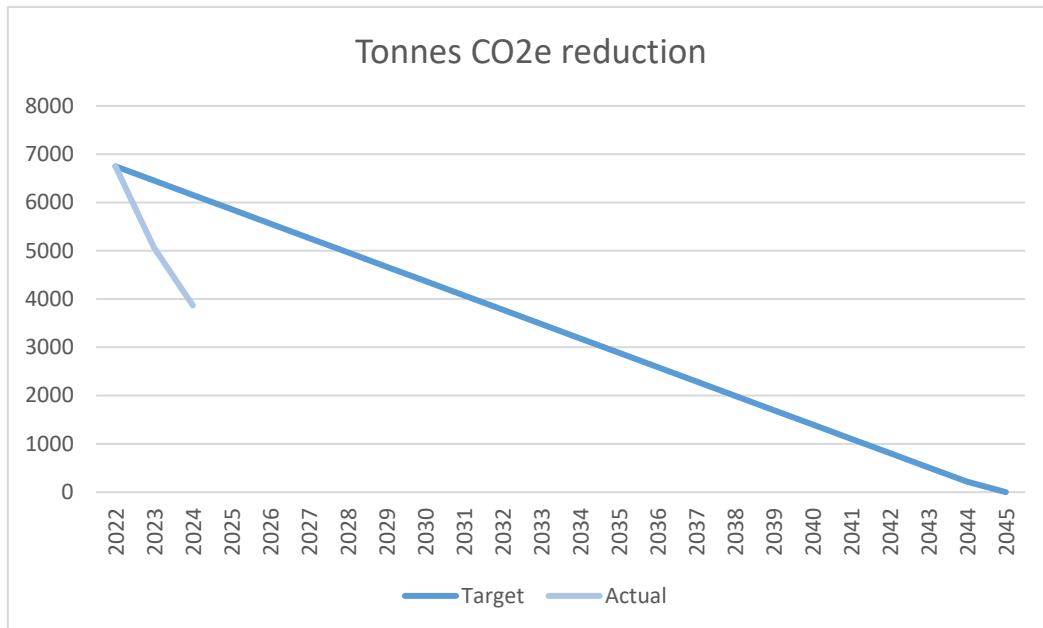
Emissions reduction targets

In order to continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets

We project that carbon emissions will decrease over the next five years by 50% against base year 2022

Carbon Reduction Projects

Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives

The following environmental management measures and projects have been completed or implemented since the 2022 baseline. The carbon emission reduction achieved by these schemes equate to a 43% reduction against the 2022 baseline and the measures will be in effect when performing the contract which is:

2882 tCO₂e

- Reduced business travel emissions through planning work routes via software systems
 - LED lighting including light switches removed for sensors
 - Energy reduction program – heating systems set at certain temperatures and with timeclocks to complement office opening and closing times
 - Installation of smart energy meters
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In the future we hope to implement further measures such as:

- Reduce business travel emissions by greening our fleet and increase use of online meeting tools. Transport emissions will fall as cars, trains and planes produce less carbon
 - Monitor and reduce commuting emissions
 - Upgrade insulation in all leased locations
 - Replace fleet vehicles to models with lower CO₂e, eventually moving to hybrid / electric options
 - Continue with the LED lighting / light switches programme
